We comply with health and safety regulations and the Welfare Requirements of the EYFS in making Haddenham Puddleducks Pre-school a non-smoking environment - both indoor and outdoor.

- All our team, parents and volunteers are made aware of our no-smoking rule.
- We display no-smoking signs.
- We actively encourage no-smoking by giving information to parents and our team about where to get help.
- Staff members/parent helpers/volunteers must not be under the influence of alcohol or any other substance which may affect their ability to care for the children.
- If a staff member is taking medication which affect their ability to care for the children they should seek medical advise.
- Providers must ensure that those staff members taking medication only work directly with children if medical advice confirms the medication is unlikely to impair that staff members ability to look after children properly.
- Staff medication on the premises must be securely stored and out of reach of children at all times.
